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Rantoul Airport – 2010 Event Application

Thank you for considering the **Rantoul National Aviation Center (RNAC)** airport for your special event activity. The RNAC airport has the space and infrastructure to support a variety of special events and we hope this is the case for your event. Please complete the application provided completely and return it to my office with a map indicating the area location you are requesting to use.

Because the “Rantoul Airport” receives state and federal grant money as a participant in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), we must conform to all applicable grant assurances. A few of the provisions IDOT/Division of Aeronautics (DOA) requires us to charge a fair-market value for rental usage of airport property. Also, depending upon the type and scope of the event (interferes or does not interfere with airport operations) your event may also require Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and DOA prior approval before you can use the airport. Your 2010 Event Application is the first step in this process. In addition, Rantoul Airport Ordinance 2173 (Rules and Regulations) also specifies what we/you can and cannot do.

Insurance is an important part of your application. The *Village of Rantoul* and current FBO - *Precision Aviation, Inc.* must be named as “Additional Insured”. Insurance documentation must be received (NLT 30 days) prior to the special event start date. Most important to all of this is airport safety and security.

All Special Event activities must not interfere with the RNAC aviation operations to include airport tenants (AT & T). For safety purposes your event activities cannot expand beyond the area designated for usage without RNAC approval. If required, spectators will be kept a safe distance from the event activity and barriers may have to be used. All established safety and control procedures for your special event will be followed. If at anytime safety or airport security is compromised, any or all activities can be stopped and/or terminated by RNAC authorized personnel.

The airport is sensitive to FOD (Foreign Object Debris) hazards. FOD is one of the major causes of damage to jet engines and tires. When your event is over, the airport area you occupied must be clean and should look better than when you first started using it.

Obviously, there are many things to consider when you plan a special event at an active airport. Your 2010 Event Application is the first step toward securing reservation. If your application is approved we will work with you concerning all the airport details that could affect your event. After the end of your event we will

bill you for the usage the airport property and any utilities involved. A \$100 Deposit is required before the event starts to help recover the cost to damage done to Village property or cleaning cost. After the event if all is O.K. your Deposit will be refunded to you or it can be used to reduce the bill total cost.

Again, thank you for considering the RNAC airport for your special event activity. We will do all we can to help make sure your event is successful. Please call or e-mail me if you have any questions.

2010 Acknowledgment, Waiver & Indemnification Agreement

The Village shall not be liable or responsible for any latent or patent defects in the Space so provided by the Village to the Applicant or for any damages to property or injury to persons which may arise from or be attributable or incident to the condition of the Space, or the use and occupation thereof, or for damages to the property of or injuries to the Applicant or the person of any of the Applicant's officers, agents, employees, or members or other who may be on the Space at the invitation of either the Applicant or any one of them. By signing this Application (front page) as provided the Applicant hereby:

- a. Acknowledges that neither the RNAC, the Village nor any of its officers, agents or employees has made any representation or warranty concerning the condition of the Space.
- b. Agrees to assume all risks of loss or damage to property and injury or death to any person by reason of or incident to the possession and/or use of the Space or the activities of the Applicant conducted under this Application.
- c. Expressly waives all claims against, and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, the RNAC, the Village and any of its officers, agents or employees for, from and against all suits, claims, demands or actions, liabilities, judgments, costs and attorney's fees arising out of, or in any manner predicted upon, resulting from, related to, caused by or arising out of the possession and/or use of the Space or any activities conducted or services furnished by the Applicant in connection with or pursuant to this Application.

I have read and will comply with each requirement identified below. Initial Each:

- 1. _____ Activity will not interfere with the daily operations of the Rantoul National Aviation Center and airport Tenants.
Ref. AT & T:
 - a. Occupy back of building parking lot will begin no sooner than _____.
 - b. Vacate parking lot by no later than _____. Prior to vacating parking lot the applicant shall return the lot back to its original condition prior to occupancy including removal of all equipment, trash, debris, oil, grease, or other stains, and repair all damaged surfaces as specified by the Village.
- 2. _____ Activity will not expand operations beyond area designated without RNAC approval. No person shall enter restricted airport grounds.
- 3. _____ All established safety and control procedures known to activity will be followed. If require, spectators will be kept a safe distance from activity and barriers will be used.
- 4. _____ No alcohol consumption is permitted.
- 5. _____ Area used is to be kept clean and all trash will be taken with user when they leave. Cleaning charges will be billed for any area not cleaned.
- 6. _____ Insurance is required. The Village of Rantoul & Precision Aviation, Inc., added as additional named insured.
NOTE: The date(s) requested for the event is contingent on insurance. Insurance must be received not later than 30 days before the event to secure the event site requested.
- 7. _____ Unless coordinated as part of the activity - no person or vehicle shall cross airport runways.
- 8. _____ Usage of Runway requires a Safety Spotter and a VHF portable radio monitoring frequency 123.0.
- 9. _____ Events that charge an admission fee will provide _____% of the Gross Profit to the Village of Rantoul
- 10. _____ Outdoor event requires a map identifying event site location, parking, potty houses, trash containers, etc.
- 11. _____ Any or all activities can be stopped and/or terminated by RNAC authorized personnel.
- 12. _____ RNAC has the right cancel the event with 48 hour prior to event starting time for reasonable cause.
- 13. _____ Village of Rantoul may/may not publicize the event to include newspaper, radio and T.V. media coverage.
- 14. _____ Any loud noise associated with the event (i.e. fireworks, music, racing engines, etc.) that can be clearly heard in residential areas and which could be considered a public nuisance will be reduce to an acceptable level. The noise level will be determined by authorized Village of Rantoul (RNAC) personnel. Future noise complaints will cause the RNAC to stop and/or terminate the event.
- 15. _____ NLT 5 days after the event, a written report will be provided summarizing the event. As a minimum identify the number of participants, number of spectators, mishaps, safety and/or security concerns, etc.

**WAIVER, ASSUMPTION OF RISK
AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT**

I, the undersigned, as the Participant, including on my behalf by my parent or legal guardian if I am under the age of 18 years, for myself and any of my heirs, personal representatives and assigns, in consideration of being permitted to participate in any way in _____

within the Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois (the "Village"), during the period from _____, 20__ to _____, 20__ (the "Activity"), do hereby release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the Village, including its officers, employees, licensees, successors, assignees, agents, representatives, and any affiliated governmental agencies and organizations (collectively, the "Released and Indemnified Parties"), from any and all claims including the negligence of the Released and Indemnified Parties, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death) and property damage arising from, but not limited to, any such participation in the Activity.

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS: Participation in the Activity carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries. The specific risks vary from one activity to another, but the risks range from (1) minor injuries such as scratches, bruises and sprains, (2) major injuries such as eye injury or loss of sight, joint or back injuries, heart attacks and concussions and (3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death.

I have read the previous paragraphs and know, understand and appreciate these and other risks that are inherent in the Activity. I assert that my participation is voluntary and that I knowingly assume all such risks.

INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS: I also agree to indemnify and hold the Released and Indemnified Parties harmless from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees, brought as a result of my involvement in the Activity and to reimburse any of them for any such expenses incurred.

SEVERABILITY: I further expressly agree that this Waiver, Assumption of Risk and Indemnification Agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Illinois and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING: I have read this Waiver, Assumption of Risk and Indemnification Agreement, fully understand its terms and further understand that substantial rights are being given up, including the right to sue. 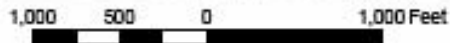
