

Police Officer Requirements

Every person applying for the position of Police Officer for the Village of Rantoul must meet the following qualifications.

1. Between the age of 21 and 34,
2. No felony convictions or convictions for Domestic Violence offenses that prohibit him or her from possessing a firearm,
3. Eyesight corrected to 20/20,
4. A citizen of the United States or an alien admitted for permanent residence (or lawfully admitted for temporary residence) who produces evidence of intention to become a citizen of the United States,
5. Every application shall be filed upon such forms as prescribed by the board, in the manner described by the board and in the time limits set by the board,
6. Each applicant must be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health and be physically able to perform the duties of such position. The burden of establishing any such qualification shall rest upon each applicant,
7. Each applicant shall be prepared to furnish a copy of the following, if applicable:
 - a) military service record, b) discharge papers, c) Social Security Card, d) Birth Certificate, e) High School Diploma or G.E.D. Certificate, f) College or university Degree and g) a certified transcript of course work from an accredited College or University.
