

Pool Rules

- All persons entering the facility for any reason must have a season pass or pay a daily fee.
- Children age 7 and under must be accompanied by a person age 14 and over.
- Riders must be at least 48" tall to use big waterslides.
- All children who are not toilet trained shall wear tight fitting rubber or plastic pants. (For example: Huggies "Little Swimmers".)
- Outside food and drinks may not be brought in to the Family Aquatic Center.
- Proper swim attire must be worn at all times. Street clothes, t-shirts, cut-off shorts, mesh shorts, leotards, underwear, etc MAY NOT be worn in the pool.
- No flotation devices of any kind (i.e. rafts, water wings or inflatables)
- Patrons exiting the Family Aquatic Center will be required to pay the daily admission fee to re-enter the facility. Does not apply to season ticket holders.
- Smoking is not allowed anywhere within the Family Aquatic Center boundaries.
- Lockers are provided for your convenience. Bring your own lock for security.
- Patrons are expected to review more specific rules posted by the Illinois Department of Health at the Family Aquatic Center.
- The Rantoul Recreation Department/Aquatic staff reserves the right to dismiss any patron not abiding by facility rules, acting in an unsafe manner or inhibiting the enjoyment of other patrons.
- Refunds will not be given to any patron at any time.

All About Pool Closings

The pool manager is authorized to close the Family Aquatic Center under the following conditions:

- The pool will be cleared for a period of 15 minutes anytime lightning is spotted or thunder is heard. Patrons will be allowed to re-enter the pool once the time has elapsed without further thunder or lightning.
- The pool will be cleared for a period of 15 minutes if a situation arises due to fecal or vomiting accident. Proper chemical/sanitation adjustments will be taken for the public health of the people in attendance.
- If the air temperature is below 70 degrees at the scheduled opening time or if the air temperature falls below 70 degrees for a continuous one hour period after opening, the pool will be closed for the day.
- If storm conditions create a clearing of the pool and there is no sign of weather clearing, the pool will close for the day.
- If there are 30 or less swimmers for a one hour period, the pool will be closed for the remainder of the day.
- Refunds will not be given if the Family Aquatic Center closes due to any of these conditions.
- The pool will be closed when a situation arises that would jeopardize public health or safety of people in attendance.
