

ORDINANCE NO. 2042

AN ORDINANCE
DESIGNATING A CERTAIN PART OF A STREET AS
HAVING AN ABSOLUTE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT AND RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, Section 25.5.10(b) of Article V of Chapter 25 of the Village of Rantoul Code-1977, as supplemented and amended (the "Traffic Code") and Section 11-604 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-604), as supplemented and amended (the "IVC"), provide that the President and the Board of Trustees (the "Corporate Authorities") of the Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois (the "Village") may determine and declare by ordinance a reasonable and safe absolute maximum speed limit on or along any part or zone of any street; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to declare an absolute maximum speed limit for part of a street pursuant to such provisions of the Traffic Code and the IVC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That an absolute maximum speed limit of 20 miles per hour is determined and declared pursuant to the above-cited provisions of the Traffic Code and the IVC to be reasonable and is hereby established for the following street or part of a street:


<u>Street</u>	<u>Location</u>
North Frontage Road (adjacent to U.S. Route 136)	From Murray Road west to terminus

Section 2. That the Public Works Director shall cause appropriate speed limit signs to be erected upon the part of such street as specified in Section 1 of this Ordinance as soon as reasonably practicable. The duty to obey such absolute maximum speed limit upon such part of such street as designated by this Ordinance shall become effective when such applicable signs are so erected.


Section 3. That all ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions designating traffic control regulations in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded.

This Ordinance is hereby passed, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, by the concurrence of a majority of the members of the Corporate Authorities then holding office at a regular meeting on the date set forth below.
