

ORDINANCE NO. 2069

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL SERGEANT POSITION
IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, under and pursuant to Section 19.2.1, entitled "Authorized Positions", of Article II, entitled "THE PERSONNEL FUNCTION", of CHAPTER 19, entitled "PERSONNEL", of the Village of Rantoul Code-1977, as supplemented and amended (the "Personnel Chapter"), any revision to the number of full-time equivalent employment positions as authorized by the annual budget or the establishment of any new employment position shall only be made by the adoption of an ordinance passed by the concurrence of a majority of the President and Board of Trustees (the "Corporate Authorities") then holding office of the Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village now desire to authorize an additional permanent Sergeant position in the Patrol Division of the Police Department of the Village and to concurrently reduce the number of permanent Patrolman positions in such Division.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Authorization. Under and pursuant to Section 19.2.1 of the Personnel Chapter, there is hereby authorized within the Patrol Division of the Police Department an additional permanent Sergeant position, such additional permanent Sergeant position to now authorize five (5) such permanent Sergeant positions. In connection with the authorization of such additional permanent Sergeant position, the number of authorized permanent Patrolman positions in the Patrol Division of the Police Department shall be concurrently reduced from nineteen (19) to eighteen (18).

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval as required by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, by the concurrence of a majority of the members of the Corporate Authorities then holding office at a regular meeting on the date set forth below.
