Chicken Coop License Application Form

No license will be given to any residential unit in any district that is not zoned R1, R2, R3 or R4 except those properties 10 acres or larger in AG (agricultural) or I (industrial) districts. **Reference: Ordinance No. 2557**

Submittal Requirements:

All items must be completed on application or license will be denied.

- Completed application
- Two (2) copies of the property site drawing showing the location of the coop, run, and where the fenced area will be located. Additionally include in the drawing, adjacent properties or ROW with measurements between the coop and adjacent primary building and streets.
- List of material and basic framing details of coop and run.
- Contact JULIE, INC. at 811 **two (2)** working days prior to digging to locate utilities after license approval.
- All residences with an HOA (home owners association) must have approval in writing from the association.
- \$20 license fee required after review and approval of application.

Inspection Requirements

- A pre-license inspection is required to validate location of coop.
- A post-license inspection is required for a final inspection of coop, electric and sign off.
