Introduction

The projects listed here represent the high priority needs for the community. **This amendment #1 proposes to transfer funds into an Economic Development - Small Business Assistance Program to assist businesses from economic losses associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. The amendment will decrease the allocated amount for the Housing Rehabilitation activity by \$95,627 reducing the allocation for that activity to \$38,807.98. The amendment would transfer the \$95,627 to a new activity titled Economic Development - Small Business Assistance, which is designed to provide business assistance in the form of working capital to facilitate the continued operation of businesses and retention of jobs due to the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.**

SMALL BUSINESS STABILIZATION GRANT PROGRAM

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Small Business Stabilization Grant Program is intended to provide working capital to existing small businesses within Rantoul, for the purpose of retaining jobs and keeping businesses operating. The program provides grant funds for working capital with a maximum grant of \$15,000 for a single business.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Eligible applicants are owners of locally owned, private, for profit businesses that employ a total of 25 or fewer full-time equivalent employees in Rantoul and that are operated within the Village of Rantoul Corporate Limits. The applicant must be operating legally in accordance with all federal, state and local laws and regulations and current with all Village taxes, fees and licenses.
- Eligible businesses are those that employ a total of 25 or fewer full-time equivalent employees and operate from a physical business building location within the Village of Rantoul Corporate Limits.
- Eligible businesses must have a total of 2 or fewer total locations from which they operate.
- Eligible expenditures of grant funds include working capital (inventory, payroll, lease/mortgage payments, utilities).
- Funds will be awarded as program budget allows. It is anticipated that a total of approximately \$300,000 in funds will be budgeted for this program.
- The amount the program is able to approve will not always be equal to the maximum grant amount due to the availability of funds.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Submit completed grant application in its entirety to the Village via email econdev@myrantoul.com. An application will only be accepted and reviewed after receipt of all application materials listed here:

- Completed grant application form
- Businesses financial statements (most recent available)
- Businesses federal tax return (most recent 2 years)
- Previous four weeks of payroll or other documents showing history of employees on payroll as of the application submission date

Each application will be individually evaluated and approved applications and grant amounts determined. Once an application is approved an award letter will be issued and grant agreement executed and grant funds will be disbursed as quickly as possible.
