

**ORDINANCE NO. 2654**

**AN ORDINANCE  
ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR ELECTED OFFICERS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.1-50-10 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et seq.) provides that the salaries that are fixed by ordinance for those officers who hold elective office for a definite term shall neither be increased nor diminished during that term and shall be fixed at least 180 days before the beginning of the term of the officers whose compensation is to be fixed; and

**WHEREAS**, it now becomes necessary and desirable to fix the salaries of the Village President, Village Clerk and each member of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Rantoul, Champaign county, Illinois (the “**Village**”) for the term beginning with the first regular or special meeting of the President and Board of Trustees in the month of May, 2021 as set forth in the Schedule of Compensation for Elected Officers as attached hereto and made a part hereof (the “**Schedule of Compensation**”).


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS**, as follows:

**Section 1. Adoption of Schedule.** That the Schedule of Compensation be and the same is hereby adopted and enacted to fix the salaries of the Village President, Village Clerk and each member of the Board of Trustees of the Village for the term of office beginning with the first regular or special meeting of the Present and Board of Trustees in the month of May, 2021.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective following its passage, approved and publication as required by law.


