


**ORDINANCE NO. 2693**

**AN ORDINANCE  
SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 10  
“BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATION” OF THE RANTOUL CODE,  
AS SUPPLEMENTED AND AMENDED, IN CONNECTION WITH ADOPTION OF  
2018 INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE**

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**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-3-2, provides that a municipality may adopt, by reference, certain regulations without setting forth those provisions in full; and,

**WHEREAS**, Article IV of Chapter 10 of the Village Code provides for the adoption by reference of the International Residential Code, 2006 edition, published by the International Code Council; and,

**WHEREAS**, the International Code Council is made up of code enforcement officials, trade industry representatives, design professionals and other interested parties who participate in establishing and revising codes for adoption and use by municipalities; and,

**WHEREAS**, the International Code Council periodically updates those certain codes which they develop and publish to assist municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, the International Code Council has published the 2018 edition of the International Residential Code; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board desires to adopt, by reference, the updated and revised version of the International Residential Code as and for its Residential Code.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS**, as follows:

**Section 1. Amendment.** That ARTICLE IV, entitled “Building Code”, of CHAPTER 10, entitled “Buildings and Building Regulation”, be and the same is hereby amended to provide as follows:

**Sec. 10-142. - Adoption by reference.**

A certain document, at least one copy of which is and has remained on file for a period of not less than 30 days prior to the adoption of the ordinance from which this article is derived and shall be kept available for public use in the office of the Village Clerk, being marked and designated as the "International Residential Code," 2018 edition, and including only appendices A, B, C, E, G, H, J, K, L and P, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the residential code (the "residential code") of the Village, for regulating and governing the construction, alteration, movement, enlargement, replacement, repair, equipment, location, removal and demolition of detached one-family and two-family dwellings and multiple single-family dwellings (townhouses) not more than three stories in height with separate means of egress as therein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees thereof; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of the residential code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out

in this article, with such additions, amendments, insertions and deletions, if any, prescribed in section 10-143.

**Sec. 10-143. - Additions, amendments, insertions and deletions.**

The following sections of the residential code are hereby revised as follows:

*Section R101.1.* Insert "Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois," for [Name of Jurisdiction].

*Section R103.* Delete Section R103 Department of Building Safety in its entirety and replace with the following: The office of the village inspector, as that office is authorized, established and provided for in Chapter 2, Article III, Division 9 of the Village Code, shall be the designated authority charged with the administration and enforcement of this code and all references in this code to the "building official" shall be deemed and construed to be references to the "village inspector."

*Section R105.2.* Delete the following in Section R105.2: Under "Building" the listed items numbered 1, 2, 4, 5 and 9.

*Section R108.2.* Add the following to the end of Section R108.2: The schedule of fees for each permit shall be in the amount established from time to time by the Village Board.

*Section R112.* Delete Section R112 in its entirety and replace with the following: The Board of Code Appeals, as that Board is created, established and provided for in Chapter 2, Article IV, Division 3 of the Village Code, shall be the Board to which any person shall have the right to appeal a decision of the village inspector under this code, and all references in this code to the "Board of Appeals" or the "Board" shall be deemed and construed to be references to the Board of Code Appeals.

*Section R113.4.* Add the following to the end of Section R113.4: Penalties for violations of this code shall be as specified in section 1-23 of the Village Code.

*Section R114.2.* Add the following at the end of Section R114.2: Penalties for unlawful continuances of work shall be as specified in section 1-23 of the Village Code.

*Section R301.2, Table R301.2(1).* Following Section R301.2, insert the following additional criteria, to-wit: TABLE R301.2(1) CLIMATIC AND GEOGRAPHIC DESIGN CRITERIA

Ground snow load: 20

Wind speed (mph): 90

Seismic design category: B

Subject to damage from:

Weathering: Severe

Front line depth: 36 inches

Termite: Moderate to Heavy

Decay: Slight to Moderate

Winter design temp.: -4

ICE barrier underlayment required: No

Flood hazards: None

Air freezing index: 1,500 or less

Mean annual temp.: 52

*Part IV-Energy Conservation.* Delete Part IV-Energy Conservation, including CHAPTER 11-ENERGY CONSERVATION in its entirety.

*Chapter 26.* Delete Chapter 26, General plumbing requirements, in its entirety.


**Section 2. Effective Date.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall, after its passage, approval and publication as required by law, become effective on June 1, 2022.

**Section 3. Conflict.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

**Section 4. Publication.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.


