AS SUPPLEMENTED AND AMENDED, IN CONNECTION WITH ADOPTION OF  
THE 2018 INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE**

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**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-3-2, provides that a municipality may adopt, by reference, certain regulations without setting forth those provisions in full; and,

**WHEREAS**, Article IX of Chapter 10 of the Village Code provides for the adoption by reference of the International Fuel Gas Code, 2006 edition, published by the International Code Council; and,

**WHEREAS**, the International Code Council is made up of code enforcement officials, trade industry representatives, design professionals and other interested parties who participate in establishing and revising codes for adoption and use by municipalities; and,

**WHEREAS**, the International Code Council periodically updates those certain codes which they develop and publish to assist municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, the International Code Council has published the 2018 edition of the International Fuel Gas Code; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board desires to adopt, by reference, the updated and revised version of the International Fuel Gas Code as and for its Fuel Gas Code.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS**, as follows:

**Section 1. Amendment.** That ARTICLE IX, entitled “Fuel Gas Code”, of CHAPTER 10, entitled “Buildings and Building Regulation”, be and the same is hereby amended to provide as follows:

**Sec. 10-300. Adoption by reference.**

A certain document, at least one copy of which is and has remained on file for a period of not less than 30 days prior to the adoption of the ordinance from which this article is derived and shall be kept available for public use in the office of the village clerk, being marked and designated as the International Fuel Gas Code, 2018 edition, including appendixes A, B, C and D, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the fuel gas code (the "fuel gas code") of the Village, for regulating and governing fuel gas systems and gas-fired appliances as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees thereof; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of the fuel gas code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this article, with such additions, amendments, insertions and deletions, if any, prescribed in section 10-301.

**Sec. 10-301. - Additions, amendments, insertions and deletions.**

The following sections of the fuel gas code are hereby revised as follows:

*Section 101.1.* Insert "Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois," for [Name of Jurisdiction].

*Section 103.* Delete Section 103 Department of Inspection in its entirety and replace with the following: The office of the village inspector, as that office is authorized, established and provided for in chapter 2, article IV, division 3 of the Village Code, shall be the designated authority charged with the administration and enforcement of this code and all references in this code to the "building official" shall be deemed and construed to be references to the "village inspector."

*Section 106.6.2.* Delete Section 106.6.2 in its entirety and replace with the following: The schedule of fees for work shall be in the amount established from time to time by the Village Board.

*Section 106.6.3.* Insert the following:

a. Fifty (50) percent for [Specify Percentage] in subsection 106.6.3(2).

b. Ten (10) percent for [Specify Percentage] in subsection 106.6.3(3).

*Section 108.4.* Delete Section 108.4 in its entirety and replace with the following: Persons who shall violate a provision of this code or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect, install, alter, or repair work in violation of the approved construction documents or directive of the code official or of a permit or certificate issued under the provisions of this code shall be liable for the penalties as specified in section 1-23 of the Village Code.

*Section 108.5.* Delete the last sentence of Section 108.5 in its entirety and replace with the following: Any person who shall continue any work on the system after having been served a stop work order, except such work as that person is directed to perform to remove a violation or unsafe condition, shall be liable for the penalties as specified in section 1-23 of the Village Code.

*Section 109.* Delete Section 109 Board of Appeals in its entirety and replace with the following: The Board of Code Appeals, as that board is created, established and provided for in chapter 2, article IV, division 3 of the Village Code, shall be the board to which any person shall have the right to appeal a decision of the village inspector under this code, and all references in this code to the "board of appeals" or the "board" shall be deemed and construed to be references to the Board of Code Appeals.


**Section 2. Effective Date.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall, after its passage, approval and publication as required by law, become effective on June 1, 2022.

**Section 3. Conflict.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

**Section 4. Publication.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.


