



“BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATION” OF THE RANTOUL CODE,
AS SUPPLEMENTED AND AMENDED, IN CONNECTION WITH
THE INTERNATIONAL WILDLAND-URBAN INTERFACE CODE**

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WHEREAS, Article XI of Chapter 10 of the Village Code provides for the adoption by reference of the International Wildland-Urban Interface Code, 2006 edition, published by the International Code Council; and,

WHEREAS, such code is particularly necessary in areas where the likelihood of wildfires exist that will impact communities; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Rantoul is not situated in such an area that the Wildland-Urban Interface Code would provide the benefits associated with the implementation of such code; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires to eliminate the adoption and use of the International Wildland-Urban Interface code within the Village.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. That ARTICLE XI, entitled “Wildland-Urban Interface Code,” of CHAPTER 10, entitled “Buildings and Building Regulation,” be and the same is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Sec. 10-356. - Reserved


Section 2. Effective Date. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Section 3. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

Section 4. Publication. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.


