



ORDINANCE NO. 2703

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 4-28 AND 4-36  
OF THE RANTOUL CODE IN CONNECTION WITH  
LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATIONS AND RENEWALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1. Amendment.** That Section 4-28, entitled "Application for license", and Section 4-36, entitled "Renewal of license", of ARTICLE II, entitled "Retail License", of CHAPTER 4, entitled "ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR", be and the same is hereby amended to provide as follows, with strikethroughs being deletions and underlining being additions:

A. Section 4-28:

Sec. 4-28. - Application for license.

Any application for a license shall be made in writing to the local commissioner and shall be signed by the applicant and verified under oath. Any such application shall be in such form and shall contain such information as may be required by the local commissioner and, in the case of an original application, shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable application fee in the amount determined from time to time by the village board. If the applicant leases the premises for which a license is sought, the applicant shall provide a copy of the lease evidencing that the lease term will be at least as long as the term of the license if issued. The applicant shall highlight the portion of the lease showing the landlord's grant of authority to sell, serve, offer to sell or serve, or allow consumption of alcoholic liquor on the leased premises. In lieu of highlighting the lease indicating the aforesaid, the applicant can provide other written confirmation from the landlord that the applicant will be authorized to sell, serve, and allow consumption, if applicable, on the lease premises.

B. Section 4-36:

Sec. 4-36. - Renewal of license.


Any licensee may renew such licensee's license at the expiration thereof, provided that such licensee is then qualified to receive a license and the premises for which such renewal license is sought are suitable for such purpose; and provided further, that the renewal privilege herein provided for shall not be construed as a vested right which shall in any case prevent the board of trustees from decreasing the number or kinds of licenses to be issued within its jurisdiction. If the licensee leases the premises for which the renewal license is sought, the licensee shall provide a copy of the lease evidencing that the lease term will be at least as long as the term of the renewal license, if issued. The licensee shall show written confirmation from the landlord that the licensee continues to be authorized to sell, serve, and allow consumption, if applicable, in or on the leased premises for which the renewal license is sought.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

**Section 3. Publication.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

This Ordinance is hereby passed, the “ayes” and “nays” being called, by the concurrence of a majority of the members of the Corporate Authorities then holding office on the date set forth below.
