



**ORDINANCE NO. 2705**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4-31 OF THE RANTOUL  
CODE IN CONNECTION WITH P-1 AND P-2 LICENSES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:**

**Section 1. Amendment.** Subsections (5) and (6) of Section 4-31, entitled "Classification of licenses", of ARTICLE II, entitled "Retail License", of CHAPTER 4, entitled "ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR", be and the same are hereby amended to provide as follows:

(5) Class P-1, package liquor license.

a. A class P-1, package liquor license shall authorize the sale at retail of any alcoholic liquor in original package form for consumption off the licensed premises where sold and not for resale in any form.

b. Samples of alcoholic liquor may from time to time be served on the licensed premises of a class P-1, package liquor license with the prior permission of the local commissioner.

c. Not more than twelve (12) class P-1, package liquor, licenses shall be issued and outstanding at any one time.

d. The fee for a class P-1, package liquor, license shall be in the amount determined from time to time by the village board.

(6) Class P-2, beer and wine license.

a. A class P-2, beer and wine, license shall authorize the sale at retail of beer and wine in original package form for consumption off the licensed premises where sold and not for resale in any form, and shall further authorize the sale at retail of beer and wine by the drink for consumption on the licensed premises where sold.

b. Samples of beer and wine may from time to time be served on the licensed premises of a class P-2, beer and wine, license with the prior permission of the local commissioner.

c. Not more than four (4) class P-2, beer and wine, licenses shall be issued and outstanding from time to time.

d. The annual fee for any class P-2, beer and wine, license shall be in the amount determined from time to time by the village board.


e. A Class P-2 license shall not be eligible for a Class VG license rider.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.


**Section 3. Publication.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.
