Details:

On 2/7/2023 I, S/A J. Haley #7108, contacted METCAD Champaign County 9-1-1 requesting the call logs and any recordings related to the above incident. METCAD responded, via email, providing me with all recordings as well as the Call Detail Records beginning with the stolen vehicle report on 2/6/2023. The following is a brief timeline surrounding the officer involved shooting gathered from the officer's radio traffic and Call Detail Records provided by METCAD:

- 2/6/2023

- **10:41 p.m.** Rantoul officers dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a vehicle stolen from the residence. Complainant Arionna Nesby [REDACTED] reports hers silver Ford Focus stolen - IL registration: [REDACTED] Nesby advised the suspect was a male black wearing a gray jacket.
- **11:02 p.m.** - Sgt. J. King (R72) locates the silver Ford Focus unoccupied near Scott and Campbell, approximately 2 blocks north of [REDACTED]
- **11:06 p.m.** Officer H. Mennenga (R74) completes an NCIC request for Azaan A.B. Lee (M DOB: 07/11/2001) who had been on scene near [REDACTED]
- **11:14 p.m.** - Officer J. Aceves (R30) calls out with a M/B wearing jeans, black coat and gray hoodie

near W. Belle and Tanner, 2 blocks south east of where the stolen vehicle was located. Subject identifies himself as Azaan A.B. Lee (M/B DOB: 7/11/01). Officer R. McComas (R83) calls out with Officer Aceves.

- **11:18 p.m.** - Officer McComas calls out “Shots fired, shots fired.”
- **11:19 p.m.** - Officer McComas calls out, “He shot once, Jose shot twice. He went north.” Officer Aceves states, “There’s a gun by the front. by our squad, can somebody get that.” Officer McComas states, “The gun went off in his sweatshirt, he may be hit.”
- **11:31 p.m.** - Annette King at [REDACTED] contacts METCAD advising someone was in their backyard moaning.
- **11:37 p.m.** - Champaign County Unit 526 advised they located a male down in the backyard of [REDACTED]
- **11:41 p.m.** - Officers advise a tourniquet was applied.
- **11:42 p.m.** - EMS Unit U8883 arrives on scene and transports Lee.

While listening to the radio traffic, at approximately 8 min and 30 seconds into the recording, Sgt. King is instructing units to set up a perimeter. Sgt. King asks, “And just to clear up, did we fire any shots or just him.” An officer, who I believe to be Officer Aceves states, “I used his own weapon. 10-4 there’s blood, he’s hit.”

On 2/8/2023 I placed all audio recordings from METCAD onto a CD, marked it as Exhibit #100 and submitted it to Zone 5 evidence drop locker #8.

NARRATIVE

Synopsis:

On February 7th, 2023 the Rantoul Police Department requested Illinois State Police Zone 5 Investigations to assist with an officer involved shooting investigation. On February 6th, 2023 at approximately 11:15 p.m, Rantoul officers had contact with Azaan A. Lee (M/B, DOB 7/11/2001). During the interaction a physical confrontation ensued and gunshots were fired. Lee fled on foot from the scene and was later located with a suspected gunshot wound. Lee was later pronounced deceased at the hospital as a result of his injury.

This report is being completed to document the review of Exhibit #101: Officer Aceves' Body Camera and Exhibit #102: Officer McComas' Body Camera.

Details:

On 2/9/2023 I, S/A J. Haley #7108 began reviewing Officer Acaves and Officer McComas' body camera footage which was collected by S/A A. Carr #6858 on 2/7/2023. Below are timelines gathered from each Officer's camera. The time stamps on both cameras are synced with each other and are in UTC (Universal Time Coordinated) which is 6 hours ahead of CT (Central Time). The timelines below have been converted to CT.

Officer McComas

2/06/2023

- **10:50 p.m.** - Video begins with Officer McComas arriving to [REDACTED] for a stolen vehicle complaint. McComas approaches Officer Mennenga who is speaking with the victim of a stolen vehicle (Arionna Nesby) and a male I recognize as Azaan Lee.
- **10:53 p.m.** - McComas speaks with Nesby's grandmother who, referring to Lee, advises he was friends with Nesby's ex-boyfriend. The grandmother advises she thinks Nesby's ex-boyfriend is responsible for taking the vehicle.

- **10:55 p.m.** - Lee approaches McComas and Nesby's grandmother asking questions about the stolen vehicle.
- **10:57 p.m.** - Lee approaches McComas a third time asking questions. McComas tells Lee he is free to leave.
- **10:58 p.m.** - Officer Mennenga advises McComas that Lee is possibly affiliated with a nearby apartment that Nesby believes is involved in the theft of her vehicle.
- **10:59 p.m.** - Lee approaches McComas a fourth time advising he knocked on a nearby apartment door but no one answered. Lee tells McComas that he had gotten a ride to that apartment and that he was supposed to go to the same place Nesby had come from, giving a confusing account of how and why he was in the area. Lee provides his information and gives an address of 1119 57 S. Emerald Chicago, IL.
- **11:02 p.m.** - McComas hears Sgt. King locate the stolen vehicle and leaves to assist him.
- **11:03 p.m.** - McComas arrives to the location of the stolen vehicle and notes, to Sgt. King, that the vehicle's not warm. McComas helps search the vehicle and then stands by with it.
- **11:10 p.m.** - McComas gets in her vehicle and turns the audio off on her body camera.
- **11:13 p.m.** - Officer Mennenga arrives with Nesby and speaks with McComas, audio is still turned off.
- **11:14 p.m.** - McComas returns to her squad car and leaves the area.
- **11:15 p.m.** - McComas arrives to Officer Aceves' location (W. Belle and Tanner) and turns her audio back on as she's arriving.
- **11:16 p.m.** - McComas asks Lee if he has any keys on him. Lee empty's his jeans pockets which contained change, a lighter and a Bluetooth headphone case.
- **11:17 p.m.** - McComas asks Lee what was in his front sweatshirt pocket. McComas shines her light on the area where you can see a heavy object weighing down the pocket pulling the pocket below Lee's outer jacket.
- **11:17:41 p.m.** - Lee reaches his right hand into the sweatshirt pocket. Acaves grabs Lee's right wrist and pats down the pocket while asking Lee what was in his pocket. Acaves asks, "What do you have right here?", while pointing at the object.
- **11:17:57** - Lee pulls away from Acaves and a struggle ensues, taking all three subjects into the grass to the west of Acaves squad car. Both officers are heard giving Lee multiple verbal commands to get on the ground.
- **11:18:08** - Lee and Acaves separate from McComas, who appears to be on the ground, and their struggle continues back towards the roadway/squad car.
- **11:18:09** - A gunshot is heard while Lee and Acaves are in a physical altercation within feet of the passenger side of Acaves squad car, Lee facing south and Acaves facing north.
- **11:18:11** - Acaves disengages from Lee, Lee runs north towards the rear of Acaves' squad car while

takes cover in front of his squad car. It appears Acaves is holding an unknown object in his left hand. Later in this video, Acaves is scene carrying a flashlight in his left hand. McComas recovers and draws her weapon.

- **11:18:13** - An unknown object, possibly metallic, is heard clanking. Lee flees running north east.
- **11:18:15** - McComas radios, "Shots fired, shots fired."
- **11:18:18** - Acaves fires three shots while McComas follows Lee's path of travel.
- **11:18:26** - McComas states, "Does he still have it? Jose, does he have it?"
- **11:18:54 p.m.** - McComas states, "He shot once, Jose shot twice."
- **11:19:20 p.m.** - McComas asks Acaves, "Did he drop the gun?" Acaves replies, "Yea...(inaudible)." McComas states, "Go back and go get it. Yea, go, ok, go secure the gun."
- **11:19:39 p.m.** - McComas states, "The gun went off in his sweatshirt. He may be hit." McComas holds a perimeter near the corner of Kentucky and Gerrard and continues advising other units Lee was last seen in that area.
- **11:29:15 p.m.** - Champaign County K9 unit arrives and McComas briefs him on the situation.
- **11:29:43 p.m.** - The K9 officer asks if this is the suspect who stole a vehicle. McComas replies:
 - o "Possibly, but we go to pat him down, or ask him to show us what he's got, and he starts reaching in his pocket. We get into a struggle with him and it goes off in his sweatshirt pocket and we start fightin' him. And I thought Jose had it, and then he fired two rounds as he was going across the tracks."
 - o The K9 officer: "Jose fired at him?"
 - o McComas: "Yes."
 - o K9 officer: "But you don't know if he hit him?"
 - o McComas: "No but, there's blood over there so I don't know, I think his round, when he fired it off in his sweatshirt, hit him but I'm not positive. You know what, I take that back, it had to be. Because Jose didn't fire until he was on the tracks so the initial blood had to be from the initial struggle which is when it went off in his sweatshirt which is across the tracks on the other side."

Officer McComas assists Champaign County K9 officer in attempting to locate Lee in a backyard near the alley running east from Gerrard.

- **11:36:38 p.m.** - Units approach [REDACTED] from the rear alley and begin making announcements.
- **11:37:15 p.m.** - CCSO K9 officer sees Lee in the corner near a fence and advises that he's down.
- **11:37:48 p.m.** - McComas and CCSO units move in towards Lee who is not responding to commands. Lee is

laying face down, with his arms underneath him, near trees. The waste band of Lee's jeans are halfway down his thigh's exposing his underwear and partial skin of the back of his thighs, his pants are soaked in a red blood like substance.

- **11:38:17 p.m.** - McComas moves in towards Lee, assures his hands are empty and units check his pulse. McComas advises units he's breathing, she then puts on gloves, rolls him over and begins checking for a pulse. McComas begins administering first aid by removing Lee's clothing and attempting to locate the wound.
- **11:40:11 p.m.** - McComas locates the wound on the inner left thigh while a CCSO unit cuts his jeans away. McComas asks if medical is close.
- **11:40:48 p.m.** - Units begin applying a tourniquet while a CCSO officer is dressing the wound.
- **11:41:20 p.m.** - The tourniquet is secured high on Lee's upper left leg near his groin.
- **11:41:56 p.m.** - McComas and CCSO deputies carry Lee out and place him on an EMS stretcher.
- **11:42:51 p.m.** - Lee is loaded into the ambulance.
- **11:45 p.m.** - McComas leaves the area and walks back to her vehicle.
- **11:48 p.m.** - McComas returns back to her squad car and briefly speaks with Acaves. McComas explains that Lee was on scene of the stolen vehicle and that she had already identified him. Acaves advises he didn't know that information. Acaves describes that he saw what he believed to be the grip of the gun in Lee's sweatshirt just before the struggle. Acaves advises McComas that he believes the gun had jammed and that his body cam had fallen off during the struggle.
- **11:53 p.m.** - McComas returns to the area of Gerard and Campbell and speaks with a CCSO deputy. The audio on her camera is turned off.
- **12:00 a.m. (2/7/2023)** - McComas assists CCSO K9 officer with an article search.
- **12:39 a.m.** - McComas' body camera is turned off.

Officer Acaves

2/6/2023

- **11:14 p.m.** - Officer Acaves' body camera activates as he's getting out with Azaan Lee, who is crossing N. Ohio Ave. walking east. Officer Acaves asks Lee if he could come talk to him.
- **11:15:11 p.m.** - Officer McComas arrives on scene.

I confirmed the times and details of the physical altercation and shots fired are the same on Officer Acaves' video as Officer McComas', see above.

- **11:18:02 p.m.** - Acaves' body camera appears to fall off and lands in the grass facing upwards.
- **11:18:13 p.m.** - A metallic clanking is heard, more faint than the noise on McComas' video.
- **11:20 p.m.** - Acaves is heard talking on the radio approaching the area of the body cam.
- **11:21 p.m.** - Acaves recovers his body camera from the ground and returns it to his uniform.
- **11:23 p.m.** - Acaves turns on his squad cars over-head lights, then walks to Officer McComas' squad car and turns on the over-head lights.
- **11:26 p.m.** - Acaves stands by a tree from a distance from the squad cars and advises, on the radio, that he's keeping an eye from a distance. Acaves stays in the area near the squad cars not saying anything other than his radio traffic, which is documented in the METCAD report.
- **11:48 p.m.** - McComas returns to the squad cars and has a conversation with Acaves, see above.
- **11:50 p.m.** - McComas walks away from Acaves, he stays in the area.

2/7/2023

- **12:03 a.m.** - A CCSO deputy arrives and begins taping off the scene, relieving Acaves.
- **12:06 a.m.** - Acaves speaks with McComas advising there's a blood trail leading to the northeast.
- **12:07 a.m.** - McComas asks, "So he was hit from the shot in his sweatshirt?" Acaves replies, "Yea."
- **12:08 a.m.** - Acaves speaks with Sgt. King advising his shots were fired towards the FS shed, pointing east/northeast.
- **12:09 a.m.** - Acaves advises he believes he shot 3 or 4 times. McComas advises she heard two shots. Acaves advises there's one shell casing in his squad "because his gun jammed" referring to Lee's gun.
- **12:11 a.m.** - Acaves gets into a CCSO squad car and is taken to Rantoul PD. Acaves mutes his body camera during the drive.
- **12:14 a.m.** - Acaves' body cam is turned off once he arrives to Rantoul PD.

 - a. Entrance Wound: Left anterior thigh, contact with muzzle imprint

- b. Track: Downward, from the right to left and front to back, with perforations of the left femoral artery and muscles
- c. Exit wound: Left posterior thigh
- d. Projectile: None recovered

Details:

On February 9th, 2023 I, Tpr. S. Hayes #6877 reviewed Exhibit 103 and Exhibit 104, bodycam footage of Rantoul Officers Haley Mennenga and Sgt. King. The following are summaries of the events when they occurred, statements listed are not verbatim unless otherwise stated.

Exhibit-103 Officer Haley Mennenga:

- **February 7th**
- **10:43 p.m.** Mennenga arrives on scene at [REDACTED] and speaks with Arionna Nesby who had reported her vehicle stolen, she advises doesn't know who stole her car.
- **10:45 p.m.** Azaan Lee appears between apartment buildings and is accused by Arionna for taking car, he advises her didn't take any car
- **10:46 p.m.** Azaan advises he doesn't know Arionna and is here to see "Ciara." Arionna says Azaan was with guy in the gray hoodie that stole her car. Azaan then advises he went to school with Arionna and knows her.
- **10:50 p.m.** McComas arrives on scene.
- **10:53 p.m.** Arionna states, "he looks like the guy that's been up there before" Mennenga asks "Azaan does?" Arionna replied no.

- **10:54 p.m.** Arionna advises she left her car running and unlocked because she was about to run to the store because she had used her babies last diaper. She had heard a car noise and ran outside to see it being driven away and car stops, and she grabs door handle.
- **10:55 p.m.** Mennenga asks Arionna who is this while pointing towards Azaan, Arionna says she doesn't know him but feels he knows who took her car. She advised she saw a thin black male in a gray jacket possibly with a black mask on.
- **10:56 p.m.** Arionna says Ciara may be linked to the incident because she has many different guys at her apartment and none of the guys have cars.
- **10:57 p.m.** Arionna says Azaan looked suspicious and that he knows who took the car and that she has a spare key for the car in Champaign.
- **10:57 p.m.** McComas advises Azaan has attempted to knock on Ciara Letrice door multiple times and no one is answering.
- **10:58 p.m.** McComas asks if she needs to question Azaan, Mennenga says no, he advised he didn't see anything however that Arionna believes he is affiliated with the apartment that the person who stole her car was at. McComas asks if they have a suspect and Mennenga says no.
- **10:59 p.m.** Arionna advises Azaan is "weird" several times
- **11:02 p.m.** Azaan approaches Mennenga squad car as she's in it to ask Arionna if she is good. Azaan then walks away.
- **11:04 p.m.** Azaan reapproaches and says Ciara won't open her door and he thought that Arionna was with her. Azaan advises he has nowhere else to go and is told to go stand over by Ciaras door. Mennenga advises Arionna her car had been located and has her sit in her car so she can drive her over to her car.
- **11:08 p.m.** Mennenga begins to transport Arionna and stops and asks Arionna's mom if she would like to drive Arionna over and meet them there to which she agrees.
- **11:10p.m.** Azaan is heard off camera asking if everything is good.
- **11:11 p.m.** Mennenga asks Azaan if he had anywhere to go and if not, he can wait at the lobby of the police department.
- **11:13 p.m.** Mennenga arrives at the scene of the stolen vehicle
- **11:14 p.m.** Arionna is asked if she thinks Azaan took her car, Arionna says it all makes sense, if he had parked where the vehicle was located at and were to walk straight through, he would of came straight through the apartment bushes.
- **11:16 p.m.** Arionna asks if she could walk the trail Azaan potentially could have walked to try and find her keys.
- **11:17 p.m.** Arionna says maybe Azaan could have been going to Ciara's house, seen her car running, took it,

seen it was her, felt bad and parked it.

- **11:18 p.m.** Mennenga leaves the scene of the stolen car to assist officers who are out with Azaan, as she leaves McComas advises shots fired over the radio.
- **11:21 p.m.** Mennenga assists setting up a perimeter and moves on foot to assist in locating Azaan who has been believed to of been shot and fled on foot. Mennenga returns to her squad car to await further instructions.
- **11:41 p.m.** Mennenga exits squad car and moves on foot to where Azaan has been located.
- **11:42 p.m.** Mennenga arrives to where Azaan was located at [REDACTED] Azaan has already been placed on a stretcher and is being attended to by EMS. Mennenga is told to drive the ambulance and gets into the driver seat of the ambulance where at 11:43 pm she drives en route to Carle Hospital Champaign.
- **11:57 p.m.** Mennenga arrives at Carle Hospital completing the transport of Azaan.
- **11:59 p.m.** Mennenga assists in bringing Azaan into Emergency Room number 23.

February 8th

- **12:03 a.m.** Mennenga terminates body camera.

Exhibit 104 Sgt. King:

February 7th

- **11:02 p.m.** King arrives on scene with the reported stolen vehicle at Scott and Campbell street.
- **11:03 p.m.** McComas arrives on scene
- **11:07 p.m.** They speak with a woman who works at the location where the stolen vehicle was left, she advises she didn't see who had gotten out of it.
- **11:13 p.m.** Mennenga arrives on scene with Arionna arriving momentarily after.
- **11:18 p.m.** Shots can be heard, and King gets into squad car to head around the area of the shooting.
- **11:18 p.m.** King asks who was shooting, McComas responds over the radio "he shot once and Jose shot, with the rest of her statement being difficult to hear.

- **11:32 p.m.** Dispatch advises of a caller from [REDACTED] of someone moaning in their backyard, King proceeds to the location on foot.
- **11:33 p.m.** King arrives at the address and waits for other units to arrive.
- **11:37 p.m.** Other units arrive and can be heard giving verbal commands, and King moves into backyard where Azaan can be seen at 11:38 p.m.
- **11:39 p.m.** King advises dispatch Azaan is breathing but unconscious and at this time believes it to be a possible gut wound. King then asks if it is in the leg, and he has a tourniquet if they think they will need it.
- **11:40 p.m.** They locate the gunshot wound to Azaan left leg and begin to apply a tourniquet.
- **11:41 p.m.** EMTs arrive on scene and move Azaan towards the ambulance.
- **11:45 p.m.** King mutes his bodycam.
- Kings bodycam remains muted for the remaining duration of the video, King walked different areas of the crime scene and spoke with several different officers on scene.

- **12:44 a.m.** King terminates his body camera.
